The Leibniz Institute of Polymer Research Dresden (IPF) is one of the largest polymer research facilities in Germany with about 470 members of staff, high competence and modern infrastructure for synthesis, analytics and simulation, as well as processing and testing of polymers and polymer materials. The approach is holistic, covering synthesis and modification of polymer materials, their characterization and theoretical investigation, up to processing and testing. A special feature of the institute activities is the close cooperation of scientists and engineers and a broad range of modern instruments and methods are available including pilot plants allowing material and technology development under industry-relevant conditions.

The IPF has been firmly established in the European research landscape since the 5th Research Framework Program. Since then the IPF has participated in about 44 projects funded directly from the EC of which 8 projects coordinated by IPF in different funding schemes (e.g. ERC, MSCA, Cooperation projects). The IPF is well connected in EU projects across the world with more than 170 stakeholders (universities, industry, SMEs across Europe, research institutions). Additionally, it participates also in other international programs like Bonus Baltic, COST actions, Era.Nets, ERASMUS/ERASMUS+ and CORNETS.

IPF has experienced personnel, a well implemented management structure and intensely working transfer networks to handle EU projects.
